Cooly Rocks On™ - Street Parade 2019

Terms and Conditions

The following Terms and Conditions have been approved by the Queensland Police Service to ensure that all Street Parade participants and general public attending the event remain safe at all times.

The Terms and Conditions should be read carefully by the individual responsible for this entry. By completing the application form, and ticking the acceptance of the Terms and Conditions, you agree to comply to these Terms and Conditions.

1. Vehicle Entries

- No articulated vehicles allowed
- Vehicle size is limited (**No semitrailers**)
- The procession order will be at the discretion of the Cooly Rocks On™ organisers
- Dangerous driving during the Street Parade assembly area is not acceptable

2. Children and Moving Vehicles

- Children on floats, decorated trucks, trailers or other moving vehicles, are to be supervised by adults at all times
- The procession order and group descriptions will be on the entry form available on-line,
- Dangerous driving during the Street Parade is not acceptable
- Children (along with all other participants), are not to leave, be removed from or placed onto a vehicle while the vehicle is moving
- Street Parade Entrant Co-ordinators are responsible for all children in their group, until they are collected by a parent or guardian
- Children must be supervised at all times. No child is to be left unattended during, or at the conclusion, of the Street Parade. Cooly Rocks On™ do not take any responsibility for unattended children on site

3. Other points to note

- It is recommended that private vehicles not participating in the Street Parade be parked in the nearby Goodwin Park area
- A parent “Drop-off Zone” will be located at Chalk Street. Children must be escorted to the Street Parade assembly area in Chalk Street

- The advertising of alcoholic drinks or prohibited substances on vehicles or on clothing, is STRICTLY FORBIDDEN
- All participants accept full responsibility for their own safety when taking part in the Street Parade and / or travelling on moving vehicles. It is therefore recommended that individuals or groups ensure they have suitable “Public Liability Insurance” in place for their participants
- Police will be present to support the Event Traffic Controllers during the Street Parade,
- First Aid will be on site and along the Street Parade route. (For immediate issues requiring assistance please dial “000”)
- All drivers of vehicles or trucks in the Street Parade must hold a current Driver’s License and corresponding vehicle class type
- A valid Driver’s license must be on all drivers during the street parade and confirmation will be required on site for inspection.

4. **Giveaway Items**

- Throwing or giving away of any object (ie. sweets, balloons, flyers etc.) is not allowed during the Street Parade and in these circumstances, it is considered dangerous and a risk and is STRICTLY PROHIBITED

5. **Street Parade**

- Marshalling of the Street Parade will take place on Sunday, 9th June 2019 between 09.30am and 11.00am. Marshalling points in Chalk Street commence at 05.30am. Entry is from the southern end via Chalk Street via Dixon Street

6. **Street Parade Route**

- The Street Parade will start in Chalk Street, > ‘right’ into McLean Street, > ‘right’ into Marine Parade, > ‘right’ into Clarke Street, > ‘right’ into Griffith Street, > ‘left’ into McLean Street and ‘left’ back into Chalk Street
- The Street Parade will be assembled in Chalk Street facing in the direction of McLean Street
- The Street Parade will set off at 09.30am with staggered departures
- Turn ‘right’ out of Chalk Street into McLean Street
- Travel along McLean Street to turn ‘right’ into Marine Parade
- Travel along Marine Parade to turn ‘right’ into Clarke Street
- From Clarke Street turn ‘right’ into Griffith Street, at the end of Griffith Street turn ‘left’ into McLean Street
- Then sharp ‘left’ into Chalk Street to disassemble
- The direction by Queensland Police Services and / or the Event Street Parade Marshalls will be final
