Car Show and Shine Entrants Connecting Southern Gold Coast Events

Please read the Terms and Conditions carefully before booking your car space. By participating in the Show and Shine Car Display and ticking the acceptance box of the Terms and Conditions, you agree to comply to these Terms and Conditions.

In these Terms and Conditions, Cooly Rocks On means Connecting Southern Gold Coast Ltd (CSGC), ABN 63 133 678 841.

The Car Entrant acknowledges that the personal information contained within the registration will be entered into an Event database. The Event Promoters (CSGC) and its key stakeholders may use the Car Entrants names, addresses and telephone numbers for future promotional, marketing and publicity purposes in any media worldwide without notice, and without any fee being paid unless otherwise agreed between the Car Entrant and event management prior to the event. By making payment of the registration, the Car Entrant is confirming that they allow their details or vehicle image to be used for this purpose. If the Car Entrant no longer consents to their details being used for future marketing purposes, the Car Entrant should make the request in writing to : cars@southerngoldcoast.com.au. Any request to update, modify or delete the Car Entrants details will be facilitated in a timely manner.

VEHICLE LOCATIONS, ENTRY & EXIT TIMES

Car Show and Shine Display is open: Saturday 6th – Sunday, 7th June 2020

- **All Zones Car Entry times:**
Saturday 6th June 2020: 05:30 am – 07:30 am
Sunday 7th June 2020: 05:30 am – 07:30 am
- **All Zones Car Exit times:**
Saturday 6th June 2020: 4:30 pm – 5:30 pm ONLY
Sunday 7th June 2020: STRICTLY after 5pm

ABSOLUTELY NO CARS CAN LEAVE PRIOR TO 5PM SUNDAY 7th June 2020

Any car that does not exit during the allocated exit time on Saturday will not be able to remove their car until Sunday 7th June 5:00pm.

- In the event that a vehicle needs to be moved in case of emergency, please seek assistance from the Event marshals,
- You agree that the Event Organisers may enter, move or tow away your vehicle for operational or safety reasons.

CHARGES AND PAYMENTS

- Car prices are listed on the website: www.coolyrockson.com.
- Registrations are strictly non-refundable,
- Registrations can be transferred to another car space (if available) or to another name. (Please contact the Events Team for further information).

VEHICLE ENTRIES

- ALL vehicles are exhibited at owner's risk,
- All entrants must hold a valid Australian Driver's license to drive the vehicle entered in the Car Show & Shine,
- 1979 vehicles and earlier are eligible to enter (This is identified by the vehicles build date as detailed on the vehicle manufacturers build plate not the vehicle compliance date – ADR Compliance Plate),
- All cars must park in their booked allocated space. Anyone parked in a wrong spot will be directed to move by the Festival Operations Manager,
- Entrants must register online via: www.coolyrockson.com (Eventbrite),
- All car registrations must be current and have license registration plates fitted, or have the appropriate permit by QLD transport,
- All car entrants must comply with QLD traffic regulations within the precinct,
- Cars can be left overnight in the allocated sites, however, it is at the owners risk. CSGC Organisers will not take any responsibility for cars left overnight within the Festival precinct,
- All registered Entrants will receive a Car Entrants pack (The Entrants pack must be collected at the Festival Registration Desk prior to the vehicle being located to their parking spot),

- **Strictly no cars are to depart their allocated car spot prior to the specified exit times or locations,**
- CSGC will not under any circumstances be liable or responsible for any damage, accidents to or theft of registered vehicles within the Festival precinct. The driver / car owner will be held responsible for any damage or any accidents that occur during the Festival and indemnify the Festival Organisers against any loss or damage it may suffer arising out of their negligence or breach of these Terms and Conditions,
- Entrants voluntarily undertake any risks associated with the Event and release CSGC employees, agents and officers from any or all liability for damage, loss or injury, however caused, that the entrants may suffer as a result of or arising from breach of these Terms and Conditions and their participation in the Event.

GENERAL

- By completing the Eventbrite registration form you agree that all information provided is true and correct,
- Any information concerning the entrant (registration), however obtained (e.g. photographs or video footage), may be used or disclosed at the discretion of CSGC for advertising, social media and publicity,
- The Car Entrant T-shirt is an additional charge and can be purchased from the Official Event Merchandise seller through the Cools Rocks On website for the driver / car owner. Very limited stock is available on-site so pre-purchasing online is highly recommended,
- Entrants will not slander or negatively comment on the festival, other Car Entrants, CSGC Management, Staff, or anyone else involved with, or connected to Cools Rocks On. Entrants will not engage in any defamatory verbal and/or written remarks against Cools Rocks On Event Organiser's, nor the Cools Rocks On event or any social media platforms. If this occurs, CSGC Management reserve the right to refuse entry into the Show and Shine Display, and potentially undertake legal action,
- No abuse of other entrants, festival attendees, CSGC Management, Staff, Volunteers, or anyone else involved with, or connected to Cools Rocks On will be tolerated in the lead up and during the festival. CSGC Management reserve the right to remove entrants displaying aggressive or abusive behavior from the precinct,
- No drugs are to be consumed pre or during the festival. CSGC Management reserve the right to remove entrants found with any prohibited substances, from the precinct,
- The QLD Liquor Act 1992 applies during the event and drinking on the street is prohibited within the festival precinct. Drinking is allowed in Licensed premises only,
- No offensive writing or images are to be visible on any car in the Show and Shine Display.

Vintage Vans

- Location of the Vintage vans will be advised closer to the Event date (if applicable),
- Sleeping in the vans in a public place is strictly prohibited and this will be enforced by the relevant Councils (Gold Coast or Tweed),
- Vintage van sites will be allocated on the day on a first-come, first-served basis.

CAR SHOW AND SHINE OPERATIONS MANUAL

- A Car Show and Shine Operations Manual will be forwarded to all Car Entrants prior to the Festival with all detailed Bump-in/Bump-Out information,
- All Car Entrants must familiarise themselves with all aspects of the Operations Manual and agree to comply.

CAR CRUISE

The Car Cruise will take place on: Saturday, 6th June 2020 - 6pm – 7.30pm

- Cools Rocks On reserve the right to change the allocated Car Cruise time,
- The Car Cruise will be available for pre-booked CRO Car entrants only and registration is limited to one cruise per car entrant booked,
- The Car Cruise is an additional cost to the Car Show and Shine Display,
- Entrants must register online via: www.coolyrockson.com (Eventbrite),
- Only Entrants booked into the car cruise may enter the car cruise. Proof of ticket entry will be required to enter the cruise and will be outlined in the Car Show and Shine Operations Manual,
- Entrants will be required to follow the route provided in their car Operation Manuals,

- Congestion will be kept to a minimum with the car cruise numbers capped,
- Marshalling for the Car Cruise and people wishing to leave on Saturday night, will need to bump-out of their zone between 4.30pm – 5.30pm Saturday, 6th June 2020,
- All entrants should be aware that the Marshalling process does take time, and long waits may occur before the cruise opens,
- The Zone Managers will guide all cars out of the precinct. No cars are to move without a Cools Rocks On Staff member present. All cars must drive at 5kms/hr with their hazard lights on when exiting the precinct,
- In order to ensure safety to our pedestrians and onlookers, strictly no lollies or other items are to be thrown out the car window at onlookers during the Car Cruise,
- All Car Cruise entrants must follow the pace of the lead car, around Kirra and through the Coolangatta precinct, adhering to the speeds as directed in the operations manual,
- In order to ensure safety to spectators and fellow car entrants, safe driving practices must always be adhered to. The speed limit of the cruise must always be followed, and cars found conducting rapid acceleration and other behaviour associated with hooning as per the 2002 amendment to the Police Powers and Responsibilities Act will not be tolerated,
- Unsafe driving practices will result in immediate removal from the Cruise and CSGC Management reserve the right to refuse entry to future Car Cruises,
- Drivers in the car cruise must be seated correctly inside their vehicles and abide by Qld driving regulations. Police vehicles will be onsite monitoring all cars through the cruise and may issue fines to any offenders.

WEATHER CONTINGENCY PLAN

- CSGC will have an approach that includes monitoring the local weather from before bump-in until the event has finished, and the crowd has dispersed. The CSGC Events Manager in consultation with the CEO will monitor the weather conditions in the lead up to and during the event,
- A wet weather contingency plan will be included in the Car Show and Shine Operations manual sent out to all car entrants, outlining the process required to be conducted in the event of severe weather. It is imperative that action must be taken to secure the site prior to severe weather reaching the site so that precautions can be taken to ensure the safety of staff and public,
- In the case of severe weather CSGC management hold the right to suspend and/or cancel cars entering the Show and Shine Display area and order an immediate evacuation of cars should they deem it unsafe to continue operating under the present circumstances,
- Notice of suspension or cancellation of the Show and Shine Display will be made via the Facebook event page and the Cools Rocks On website and all car entrants must check these platforms in the first instance. Every effort will also be made to personally contact all car entrants via email, text or in person, but cannot be guaranteed,
- All car entrants must follow CSGC management's advice and any car entrant not adhering to this will be liable for any damages to public and surroundings and will not be invited back to any future events,
- Should the Show and Shine Display be cancelled, CSGC reserve the right to not issue any refunds for the cancellation,
- CSGC is not liable for failure to perform any obligations if such failure is as a result of Severe weather, labour dispute, strike, lockout or failure of electricity or telephone service,
- CSGC is not liable for performance attendance, or festival attendee numbers at the event,
- CSGC management reserves the right to alter bump-in and operating times during the festival due to weather, safety or unforeseen circumstances.
- CSGC do not accept any liability of any damage to cars due to bad weather.
